As we head towards Spring and Nags September Championship organisation and running we must once again ask for our members assistance for writing, running, arena set up and to be general hands on deck .

The three day competition is on the 23rd 24th & 25th of September with entries closing on the 26th of August.

As we had to cancel the July Official we will now hold the Flavelle Shield on the Friday of the Championships which falls during the school holidays.

The Flavelle Shield is a much coveted trophy event as a memorial for Kim Flavelle who was a talented young local rider.

It is an Unofficial Novice class for 16 years and under riders and I would encourage all young riders to enter this class regardless of whether you are riding in the rest of the Competition.

For insurance reasons all riders will have to be Nags or EA members – Nags Day membership may apply.

Many of our regular riders do not enter and compete at the larger events like the Championships so I pose the question – What type of events do they like to ride at?

Nags is a not for profit organisation, a collective of like minded horsey people who between them can fundraise, advertise, organise and run any type of event at any level from Social Training type of days that attract anyone from small kids up - To Two Star Dressage Championships that attract the professionals from far & wide.

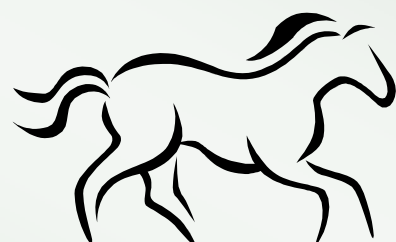
ASSOCIATE TRAINING REPORT

Entry Fees:

Volunteers \$5.00 per class, \$10.00 per stable (You must be a Nags member and you will be required to help out on the day (penciling, marshalling or at setup the previous day).

Non Volunteers: \$15.00 per class, \$20 per stable

This event is open to Nags Members ONLY, Day Membership available for \$20.00 maximum of 2 days per calendar year allowed. You must sign waiver to compete.

Payment: Cheque for postal entries and Nominate for others

Prizes: As this is not a standard competition format, no prizes will be given. You will receive your test sheets.

This event will not count for the end of year awards.

Classes Offered:

Riders can enter the same test twice. All test sheets will be handed directly back to the rider for examination.

The second test in that class will be ridden between 30 and 60 minutes after the first test (depending on entry numbers).

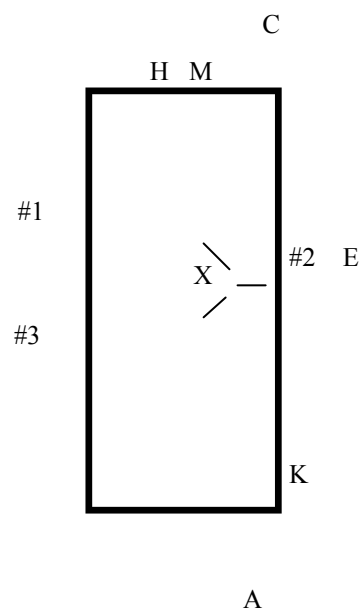
Maximum 2 horses per rider, Maximum 3 tests per horse at 2 consecutive levels only

Riders wishing to use non EA approved gear will need to apply on entry form to use other riding gear(ie, stock saddles, running martingale, bitless bridles) all non EA approved gear will need to be safe and offer no negative welfare aspects to the horse. Gear must also be pre-approved by the committee and the committee decision is final.

Prix Caprilli Test #1

For horses with jumping experience showing Training Level Dressage or above - maximum height of fences 2 feet. It is understood that in the working gaits, a jumping horse is not expected to be as round on the bit as a competing Dressage horse. The horse must softly accept the bit and may show more "roundness" in the parts of the tests separate from the jumps. Trot work to be done posting. Transitions into and out of the halt may be through the walk. Test may be called. Refusals will be penalized as an error of course. Knockdowns will be penalized at the judge's discretion. In the case of a knocked down rail being in the way, the judge will ring the bell for the rider to stop without penalty. After the jump is replaced, the bell will be rung again telling the rider to continue from where he stopped.

1. A Enter working trot.
X Halt. Salute. Proceed working trot.
C Track right.
2. MXK Change rein over Fence #1. Return to working trot after jump.
3. A 20m. circle left.
4. Before F Turn on line to Jump #2. Return to working trot after jump and proceed toward M.

5. C Medium walk.
6. HB Free walk. (x2)
B Medium walk.
7. F Working trot.
F
8. Bet. A & K Working canter right lead.
9. KXM Change rein over Jump #1, land in working canter.
10. 10. M Working trot.
11. Bet C & H Working canter left lead.
12. E Large 1/2 circle left over Jump #2. After jump, proceed straight ahead.
13. Opposite M Working trot.
14. C Circle 20m. letting the horse gradually chew the reins out of the hands at working trot, rising. Before C gradually take up the reins.
C straight ahead.
15. HXF Change rein over Jump #3. Return to working trot before F.
16. A Down centerline
X Halt. Salute. Leave arena at a free walk on a loose rein.



General Impressions:

Gaits (rhythm and clarity) and jumping style (x1)

Suppleness and balance (longitudinal and lateral, ability to shorten and lengthen) (x2)

Relaxation and Obedience (tempo, attention, confidence, harmony, acceptance of the bit) (x2)

Position and Seat of rider, timing to jumps (x3)
