

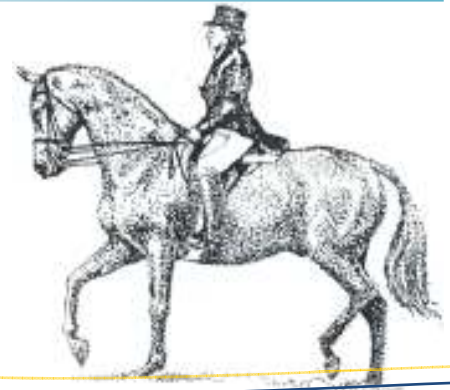

Position near the foot and unfold - easy as 1-2-3-4-5



Easily secured - just drop in the pin



Use it on the side or the back of the foot - we supply 3 sets of brackets so you can choose the position depending on available space or shade. This new attachment can be very useful if you have to get your horse out for a spell or in an emergency when travelling.

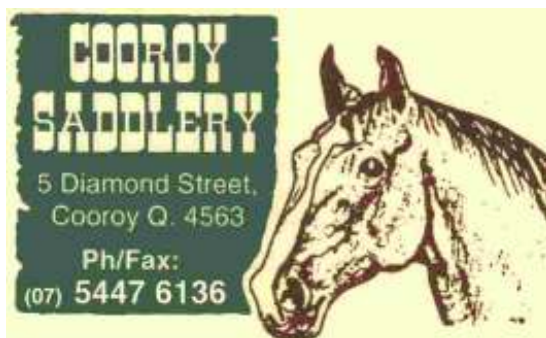

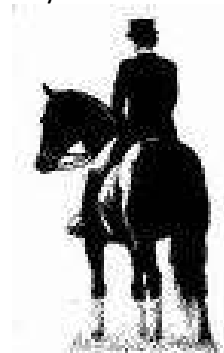
